#### Field Archery.

By comparison with many other counties, Shropshire is not a hotbed of Field archery (shooting at various distances at 2D or 3D models of animals in the woods. Having said that, 3 of the county’s clubs do have a field archery course. Once a month (2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday in the month) an open Field Archery competition is held near Shrewsbury, hosted by Bowbrook Archers. This combines good shooting with excellent company and fantastic Bacon butties. There is also an open Field archery practice session (no bacon butties) on the 4<sup>th</sup> Saturday of each month. It really helps if you can let the organisers know before an event that you wish to attend – numbers are limited (so is car parking) – and it helps with catering. The membership picture across the county is mixed over the last 12 months – some clubs have grown, others have fewer members. But the general picture is positive, in line with the trend in ArcheryGB's National membership.

At least there was virtually no wind which always helps when shooting clout. It was good to see so many juniors taking part – they came away with 5 new County records plus a National record.

As ever, thanks to Adams Grammar school in Newport for letting us use the venue and to Bowbrook Archers for hosting the event.

Note; The 2017 Shropshire Clout will be held at Longford Hall, Newport on Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> October.

Regular open Clout practice sessions will be held at Bowbrook Archers' field – approximately every month.

## Indoor archery competitions.

**Don't forget the Shropshire County Indoors championships – hosted by Telford Archers. This will be held on Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> February in the Sports Hall at TCAT (same venue as last year).**

**The organiser is Jayne Clarke – I understand that entry forms for this event will shortly be sent out to all Shropshire's archery clubs – the form will also be posted on the County Web site. Get your entry in early – last year this competition filled up very quickly and some archers were disappointed.**

**The West Midlands Indoor championships are also coming up. At this stage we know the dates are 31<sup>st</sup> January for Juniors and 6 March for seniors. For more details look at the WMAS website in due course. No Venues known at this stage.**

We are hoping to get the next County Newsletter out around Easter time. This will have details of all the Summer's events planned in Shropshire.

Dates for almost all the Heritage shoots have now been set as well as the Wenlock Olympians event which we understand will be held on July 10<sup>th</sup> at Attingham Park in 2016.
