Adcote is located approximately 5 miles west of Shrewsbury near to Great Ness. Travelling from Shrewsbury, take the B4380 Holyhead road from Shelton to Montford Bridge. Just after crossing the river Severn turn right to Forton. In ½ mile turn left to Little Ness.

Adcote is on the right in approximately 1 ½ miles.

Lady recurve archer with a handicap of 50 = 436 National Gent recurve archer with a handicap of 44 = 500 National Lady compound archer with a handicap of 42 = 518 National Gent compound archer with a handicap of 37 = 555 National

- Juniors wishing to shoot in the senior rounds will pay the senior fee to do so, and will be competing against the seniors for medals.
- Juniors wishing to shoot a higher round than their own (within the junior rounds) will still pay the junior fee, but will compete against the age group they are shooting in for medals.
- Medals will be awarded over all categories depending on how many archers are shooting within that category, as follows:

Gold = awarded if there are 1-3 people shooting Silver = awarded if there are 4-6 people shooting Bronze = awarded if there are 7 or more people shooting
